


Current Transducer LB 1000-SI/SP2

For the electronic measurement of currents: DC, AC, pulsed..., with a galvanic isolation between the primary circuit (high power) and the secondary circuit (electronic circuit).

Ignoring this warning can lead to injury and/or cause serious damage.


This transducer is a built-in device, whose conducting parts must be inaccessible after installation.

A protective housing or additional shield could be used.

Main supply must be able to be disconnected.

Mechanical characteristics

- General tolerance
- Fastening

Recommended fastening torque

- Primary through-hole
- Connection of secondary
- ± 0.5 mm
- 4 slots Ø 7 mm
- 4 M5 steel screws
- 4 Nm or 2.95 Lb. Ft.
- Ø 40 mm

Faston 6.3 x 0.8 mm.

Remarks

- I_s is positive when I_p flows in the direction of the arrow.
- Temperature of the primary conductor should not exceed 100°C
- Dynamic performances (di/dt and response time) are best with a single bar completely filling the primary hole.
