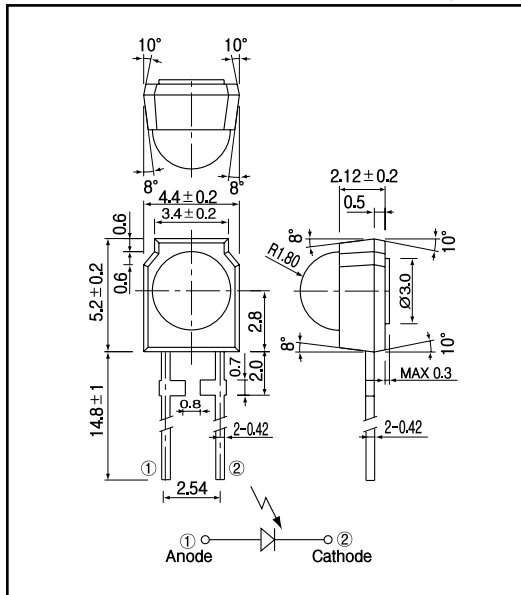

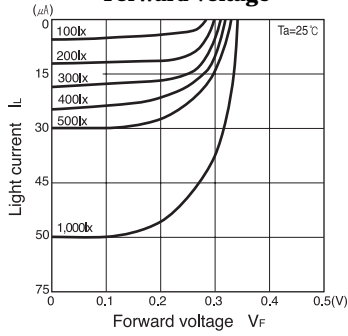

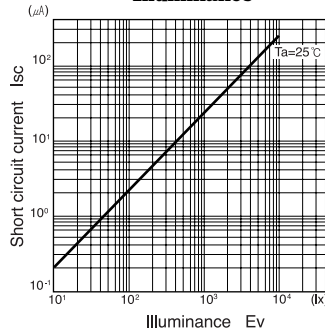

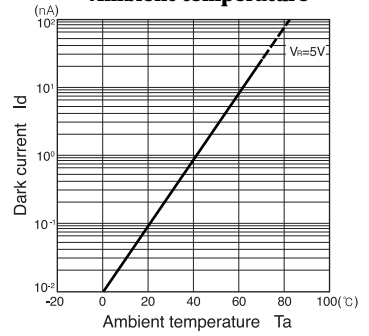
Light current Vs. Forward voltage



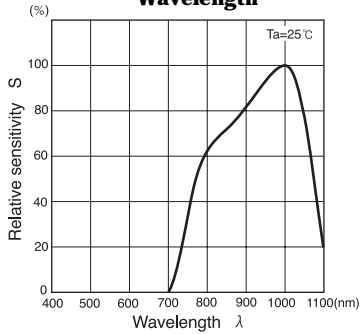
Short circuit current Vs. Illuminance



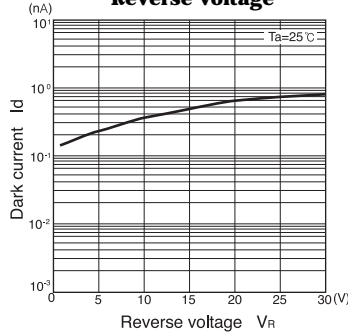
Dark current Vs. Ambient temperature



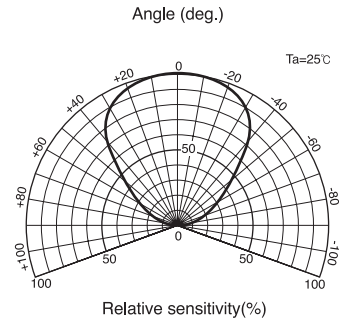
Relative sensitivity Vs. Wavelength
