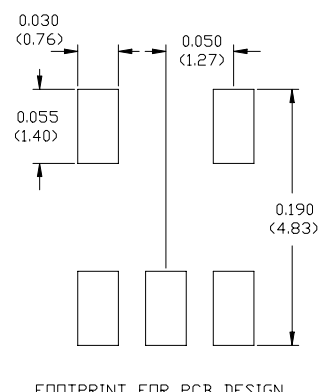
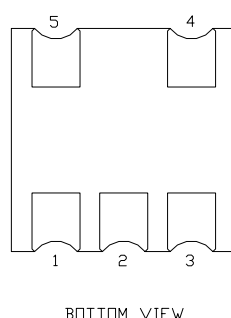
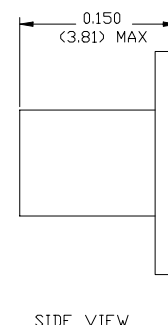
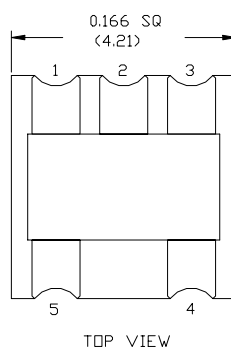
Schematic

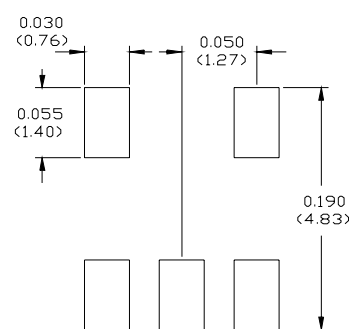

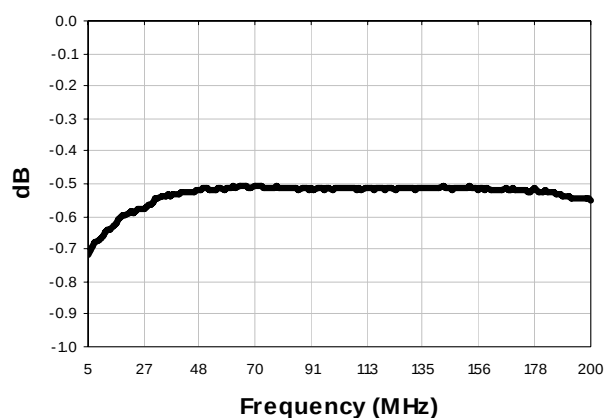
FOOTPRINT FOR PCB DESIGN

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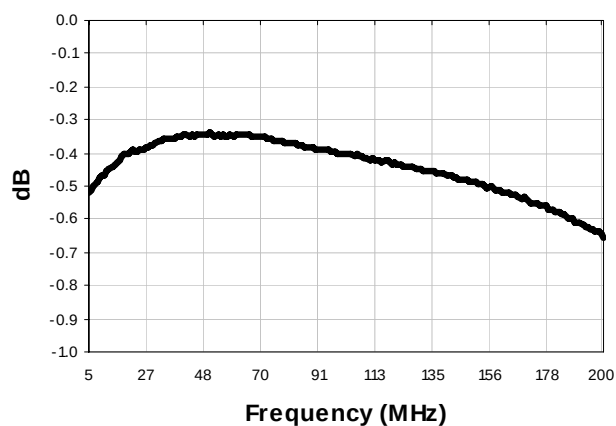
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Typical Performance Curves: $T_A = 25^\circ\text{C}$, $Z_0 = 75\Omega$ ¹

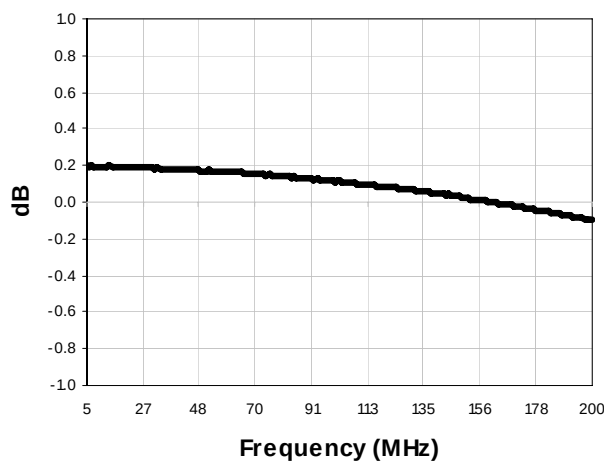
Insertion Loss 1: pin 5-3



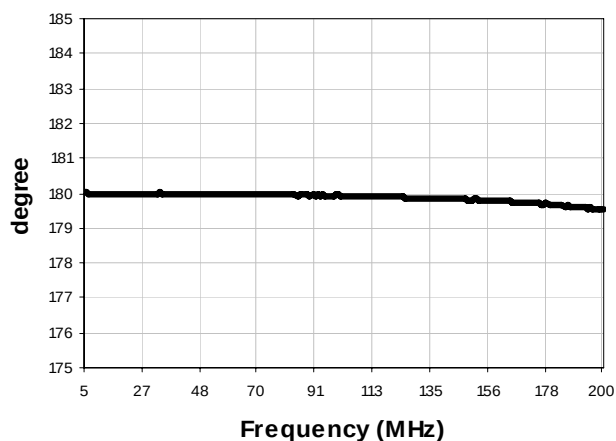
Insertion Loss 2: pin 5-1
