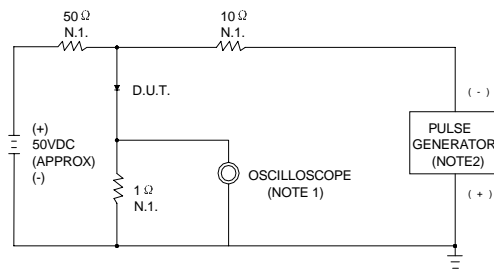

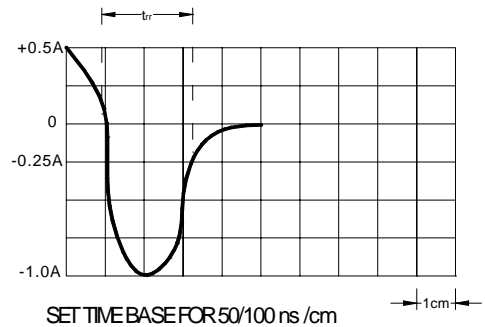

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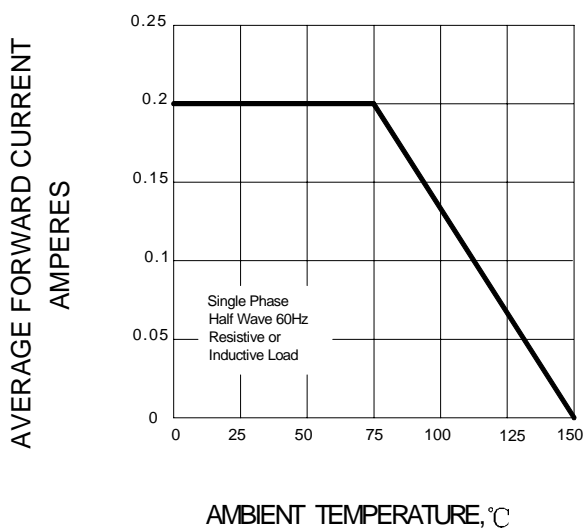
**FIG.1 – REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC AND TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM**



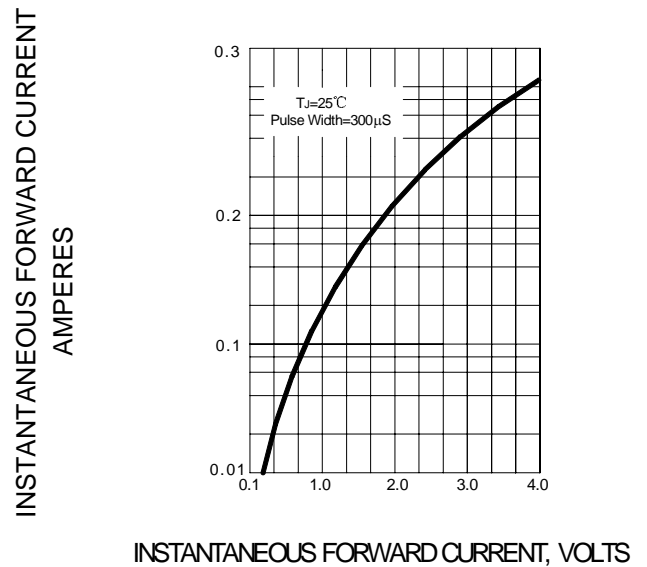
NOTES: 1. RISE TIME=7ns MAX. INPUT IMPEDANCE=1MΩ, 22pF  
 2. RISE TIME=10ns MAX. SOURCE IMPEDANCE=50Ω



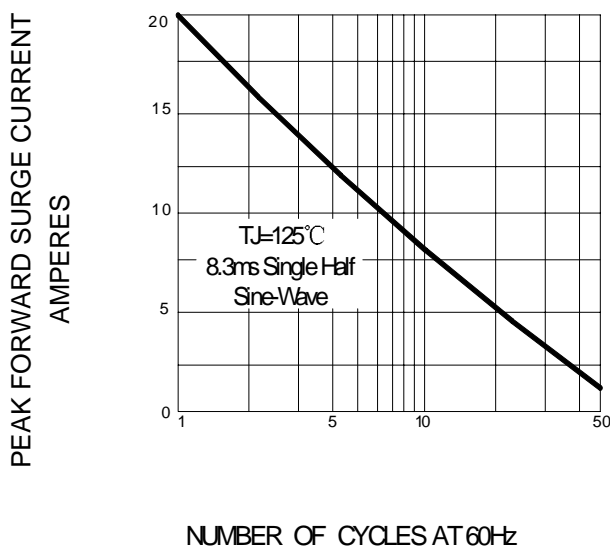
**FIG.2 – TYPICAL FORWARD DERATING CURVE**
