

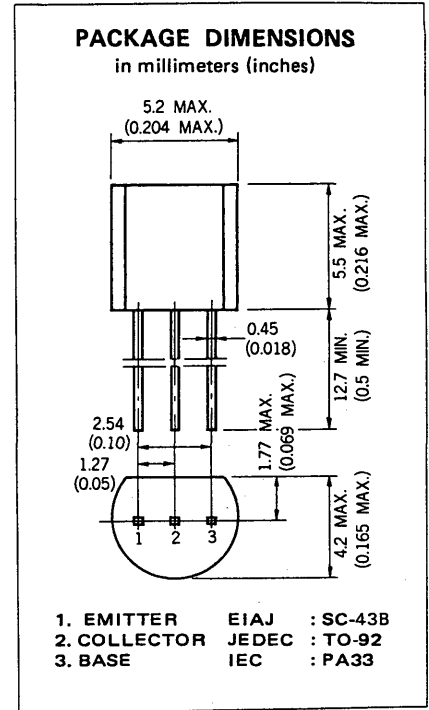
DESCRIPTION The 2SD1513 is designed for use in driver and output stages of audio frequency amplifiers.
