The D5CC series of SAW antenna duplexer apply to the frequency range 700 to 1000 MHz.



The D5CC series with of transmitter filter, receiver filter and matching circuit are housed in a small package, so it can contribute to save mounting space and weight.














(1) Reel Dimensions
