




Fig 2. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of junction temperature





Fig 3. Normalized continuous drain current as a function of junction temperature


Fig 4. Safe operating area; junction to ambient; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage







Fig 7. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values



Fig 9. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values





Fig 8. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage



Fig 11. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values






Fig 12. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance as a function of ambient temperature; typical values


Fig 13. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature

Fig 15. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values





Fig 16. Gate charge waveform definitions







Fig 17. Source current as a function of source-drain voltage; typical values


