


Fig. 1 - Reverse Current vs. Junction Temperature




Fig. 2 - Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage




Fig. 3 - Diode Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage


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


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### PACKAGE DIMENSIONS in millimeters (inches): QuadroMELF SOD-80
