



This technology is tailored to minimize conduction loss, provide superior switching performance, dv/dt rate and higher avalanche energy. Consequently, SuperFET II MOSFET easy-drive series offers slightly slower rise and fall times compared to the SuperFET II MOSFET series. Noted by the "E" part number suffix, this family helps manage EMI issues and allows for easier design implementation. For faster switching in applications where switching losses must be at an absolute minimum, please consider the SuperFET II MOSFET series.

Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics




Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation vs.

Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 5. Capacitance Characteristics




Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 4. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation vs. Source Current and Temperature





Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics

Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation vs. Temperature




Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area




Figure 11. Eoss vs. Drain to Source Voltage




Figure 8. On-Resistance Variation vs. Temperature





Figure 10. Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature

Figure 12. Transient Thermal Response Curve




Figure 13. Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform




Figure 14. Resistive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms





Figure 15. Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms







Figure 16. Peak Diode Recovery dv/dt Test Circuit & Waveforms
