





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N-CHANNEL 1 TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS ($T_A = 25$ °C, unless otherwise noted)



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
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

Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature

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
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




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N-CHANNEL 2 TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS ($T_A = 25$ °C, unless otherwise noted)



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
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
N-CHANNEL 2 TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS (T_A = 25 °C, unless otherwise noted)






