## High-speed Switching Applications

- HN2S02JE is composed of two independent diodes.
- Low forward voltage:  $V_F(3) = 0.54V$  (typ.)
- Low reverse current:  $I_R = 5\mu A$  (max)

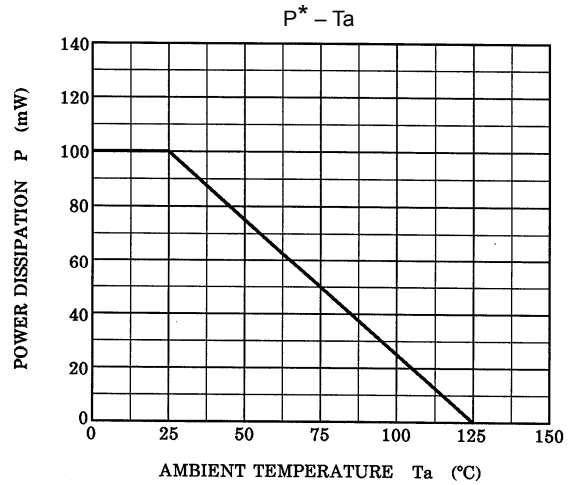
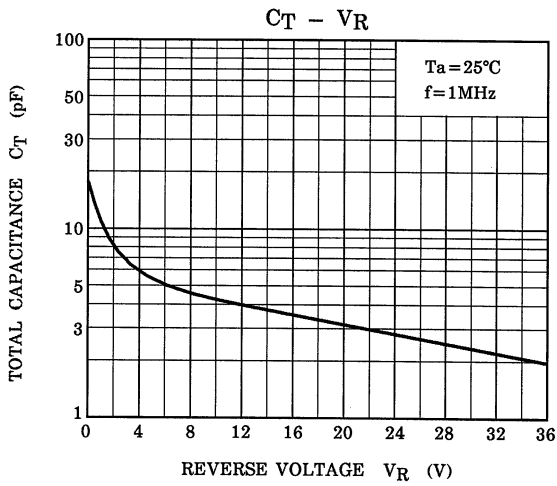
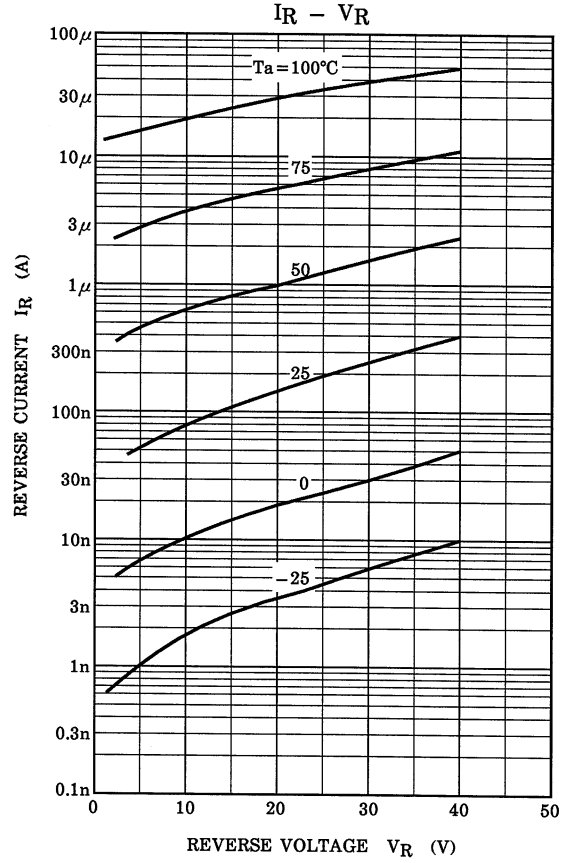
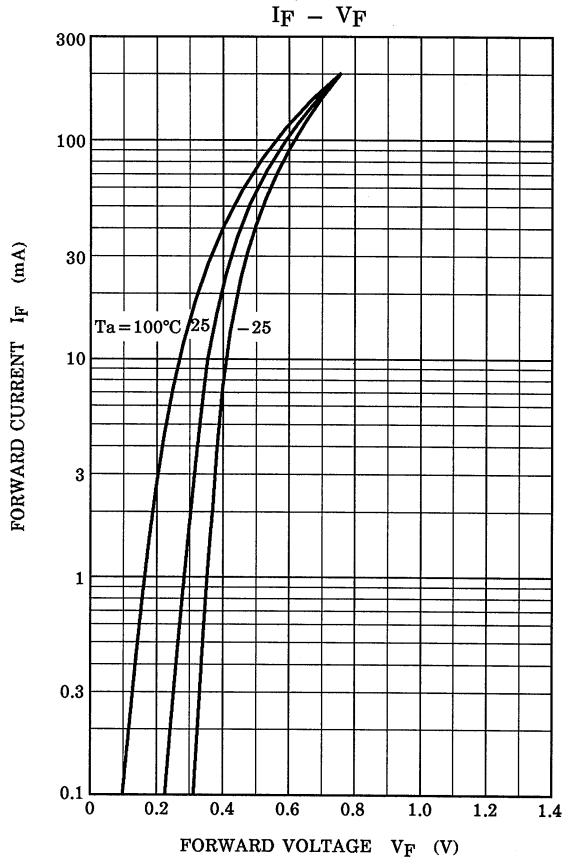
## Pin Assignment (Top View)
